To implore Your heavenly blessings in abundance once again, We have come here today, as the present day Irish generation of the faith which our ancestors treasured, preserved and handed down to us, even at the cost of their lives. Through the intercession of the Hearts of Your Son Jesus, the Divine Majestic King, and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, Queen of Ireland, to whom we consecrate ourselves and our nation today, may You bless Ireland with a renewed sanctification by the fire of the Holy Spirit. So that the faithful thronging in ever greater numbers to Your Church, will form the heavenly Jerusalem throughout our land. **Amen**

Heavenly Father, Your very own words in referring to Yourself were “I am God not of the dead but of the living”.
